## BACKGROUND

The Indian Constitution, adopted on 26<sup>th</sup> November 1949 and coming into effect on 26<sup>th</sup> January 1950, serves as the foundational document that defines India's democratic, secular, and egalitarian framework. Over the past seven decades, it has guided the nation through political, social, and economic transformations, ensuring justice, liberty, equality, and fraternity—the core principles of India's governance. These values are celebrated annually on Samvidhan Diwas or Constitution Day.

To commemorate the momentous occasion of India's 75<sup>th</sup> year as a Republic, the Department of Justice proudly inaugurated the pan-India year-long campaign, 'Hamara Samvidhan Hamara Samman'. More than just a commemoration, this initiative became a resounding call to action for every citizen to actively contribute to shaping the vision of Viksit Bharat by 2047.

The yearlong campaign was launched to raise awareness about the significance of the Constitution in shaping Indian society and to educate citizens on their legal rights, ensuring that the foundational principles continue to resonate with every Indian.

b) ***Nav Bharat, Nav Sankalp:***


- Encouraged citizens to think of themselves as active participants in the democratic process.

The Panch Pran Pledge is a solemn commitment inspired by the vision articulated by the Hon'ble Prime Minister of India Shri Narendra Modi. It encapsulates-

- Pride in our traditions,
- Dedication to unity and integrity,
- Awakening a sense of duty in every citizen.

To take the pledge, citizens can visit the MyGov platform and recite the pledge to generate e-certificates. To permeate this initiative to village level, Village Level Entrepreneur (VLE) spanning over 2.5 Lakh Gram Panchayats encouraged citizens to take the pledge.

QR codes linking to the MyGov Platform campaign page were displayed in CSCs and shared on social media and WhatsApp groups of CSC functionaries to spread awareness and encourage citizens to be a part of this noble activity.

With over 1,33,000 citizens taking the Panch Pran Pledge, this initiative successfully served as a medium to involve individuals in the nation-building process, rekindling the spirit of patriotism and fostering a sense of responsibility among citizens.





Age wise





The Nyaya Seva Mela is a State-level workshop cum Mela organized across 25 States and UT. DLSA/SLSA/Legal Aid Clinics of law schools participated in the workshop which encouraged the discourse of State schemes and programs of the Department of Justice.

The Mela observed the release of 4<sup>th</sup> edition of Voice of Beneficiaries in the regional language of the respective States, Tele-Law State Profile Booklet and felicitation Field Functionaries. A workshop in each State was also organized which reached out to the local population and made more people aware of the Tele-Law service and the ‘Hamara Samvidhan, Hamara Samman’ campaign.

The Melas were followed by a widespread promotion on social media and news channels which included both print and digital media and it reached more than 84,65,651 citizens across India.



Nyaya Sahayaks are community-based legal messengers tasked with delivering door-to-door awareness of legal services and solutions offered by the Department of Justice in Aspirational Blocks and Districts.

To achieve the desired objective, Nyaya Sahayaks were assigned unique IDs for referral purposes, which were used during citizen transactions within the performance dashboard. This initiative aimed to introduce a technological enabler with human support at the block level, acting as a bridge for doorstep delivery of legal services and encouraging local participation. To tap into the maximum productivity of the Nyaya Sahayaks, they were given due incentives based on their performance.

The Nyaya Sahayaks not only imparted legal knowledge to beneficiaries but registered 14,598 plus cases. In addition to the commendable efforts of the Nyaya Sahayaks, “Vidhi Baithak” sessions at the village or block level, with guidance from Block Level Officers, were also conducted to spread legal awareness. Five Baithaks were held monthly at various locations, engaging cross-sector groups such as School Management Committees, Panchayat Samiti/Gram Sabha, Anganwadi Workers, Self-Help Groups, and Children/Observers.

## NAV BHARAT NAV SANKALP

The Nav Bharat Nav Sankalp Campaign is an initiative designed to promote awareness of the principles of Panch Pran and the Constitution among citizens, particularly the youth, through the MyGov platform. The campaign features four interactive activities:

### SANKALP SAKSHARTA

An online Pledge was hosted on the MyGov platform, where citizens can read and take the Panch Pran Pledge. Upon reading the pledge, they were rewarded with e-certificates and the majority of participants included DISHA functionaries, stakeholders of Tele-Law program, students and teachers of Pro Bono Clubs and Implementing Agencies of Pan India Legal Literacy and Legal Awareness Program. The expected outcome of this activity was to increase awareness and participation among citizens on the theme of Panch Pran.

### SAMVIDHAN QUIZ

An online quiz was hosted on the MyGov platform which was designed to educate participants about the creation, key features, and evolution of the Indian Constitution. With a broad reach, it was made available in English and Hindi language, ensuring accessibility for a diverse audience across the country. Under this activity, top 1000 entries were selected who gave the maximum correct answers. 1000 winners were given Rs. 1000 each at the end of the campaign. The top three winners were acknowledged by the Department of Justice.

### PANCH PRAN RANGOSTAV

An online poster making competition on the theme of Panch Pran was hosted on the MyGov platform. This competition invited citizens to create posters reflecting the five resolutions (Panch Pran). The posters of the winners will be featured in the 2025 DoJ calendar. The expected outcome of this activity was to promote and creatively visualize the resolutions critical for India's development.

### PANCH PRAN ANUBHAV

A selfie video competition and social media campaign focusing on the Panch Pran was hosted under this initiative. This campaign successfully engaged thousands of young minds, fostering a deep sense of patriotism and responsibility towards the Indian Constitution.

The expected outcome was not only to inspire the youth to embrace their constitutional duties but also to strengthen their commitment to building a progressive and inclusive nation.





# VIDHI JAGRITI ABHIYAAN

Legal Literacy awareness camps were organised by the Pro Bono Clubs under Nyaya Bandhu and Pan India Legal Literacy and Legal Awareness Programme in collaboration with partner agencies across India, this sub-campaign encompasses three transformative initiatives:



Students organised legal awareness activities within adopted villages ensured participation of citizens at the ground level. Photographs and reports of the activities conducted were uploaded by the students to a designated dashboard. This initiative witnessed a significant outreach of more than 10,000 beneficiaries.



## VANCHIT VARG SAMMAAN ABHIYAAN

Through this initiative, the Department joined hands with IGNOU and Doordarshan to organize online workshops/webinars covering various marginalized groups' rights.

Under the Vanchit Varg Saman Abhiyan, below mentioned 7 topics were leveraged-

- i. Honoring the Rights (children, women person with disabilities, SC, Transgender and Senior citizens).
- ii. Children in need of care and protection
- iii. Outraging modesty of woman
- iv. Social inclusion of persons with disabilities
- v. Social security schemes for Schedule Castes
- vi. Inclusive social welfare scheme for transgender
- vii. Senior citizens legal aid and awareness

Through this initiative, online workshops/webinars addressing gender-based issues were conducted for wider dissemination, leading to fostering legal consciousness among diverse segments of society and empowering citizens with knowledge.

Various programs at the village level were organised by Implementing Agencies such as National Law School of India University, Bengaluru, Karnataka, Vivekananda Institute of Professional Studies, National Law University, Delhi, etc on various topics addressing violence against women.

Webinars, talk shows in hybrid mode were organised by Sikkim State Women Commission, and IGNOU on socio-legal topics like “Understanding Cervical Cancer”, “Constitutional Values” “Protection of Women from Domestic Violence” “Children in Need of Care and Protection and Children in Conflict with Law” and “Sexual Harassment at Workplace”.

It is significant to note that Doordarshan, in collaboration with DoJ under the DISHA Scheme, developed 77 TV programs addressing various legal awareness issues. These programs focused on the empowerment of senior citizens, persons with disabilities, women, children, and transgender individuals. As on December 2024, 77 episodes have been broadcast across 11 national and regional Doordarshan channels in 8 languages reaching an audience of 70.04 lakh. It is also available on the YouTube of DD handle.




# HAMARA SAMVIDHAN HUMARA SAMMAN EVENTS



## GROWTH STORY

Launched on the 24<sup>th</sup> of January 2024, to reaffirm the collective commitment to the principles enshrined in the Constitution of India and celebrate the shared values that bind our nation, “*Hamara Samvidhan, Hamara Samman*” was implemented.



## NATIONAL EVENT

The initiative was launched with a grand National Event in Delhi, where the Hon'ble Vice President of India, Shri Jagdeep Dhankar in the august presence of Hon'ble Minister of State (I/C) for Law and Justice, Shri Arjun Ram Meghwal, Shri R Venkataramani, Attorney General of India and Shri S.K.G Rahate (former) Secretary, Department of Justice, inaugurated the "Hamara Samvidhan Hamara Samman" initiative. This marked the beginning of a significant movement, highlighting the importance of constitutional values and human rights.

The event commenced by launching the key sub-campaigns of this initiative -Sabko Nyaya-Har Ghar Nyaya, Nav Bharat Nav Sankalp, and Vidhi Jagriti Abhiyaan and their respective activities. The event discussed about organizing the citizen centric service melas called "Jan Sewa Janta ke Dwar" which focused on conducting workshops on legal services across States/ UTs across country.

The event also witnessed the release of the DISHA Achievement Booklet for the year 2021-2023 and the formalization of collaborations with Bhashini to build multi-modal interface to address the legal queries of the citizens in their language.

A gathering of 650+ participants comprising of law students and teachers, representatives from different Ministries/ Departments, NALSA, VLEs and officials from CSC, media etc., attended the event. 70 Lakh + audience were reached through different print, electronic and social media handles ensuring that this year long pan India campaign touched every nook and corner of society.



## 1<sup>ST</sup> REGIONAL EVENT IN BIKANER

Following the National Launch, the first regional event was held in Bikaner on 9<sup>th</sup> March 2024 and was graced by the presence of the Hon'ble Dr. Justice D.Y. Chandrachud, Former Chief Justice of India (CJI), Shri Arjun Ram Meghwal, the Hon'ble Union Minister of State (I/C) for Law & Justice, Hon'ble Mr. Justice Manindra Mohan Shrivastava, Chief Justice of Rajasthan High Court and Shri Joga Ram Patel, Law Minister, Government of Rajasthan and other high-level dignitaries from the State Government of Rajasthan.

The event featured the official release of innovations to spearhead legal services at the grassroots, such as the “Nyaya Sahayak” program for 500 Aspirational blocks of India. The event also showcased a special women edition of Voices of Beneficiaries and a State Booklet of Rajasthan, which reflected the growth and coverage of the Tele-Law program. The event also featured dignitaries addressing the importance of human dignity and the need for technological advancement in India.

The Hon'ble Minister of State for Law and Justice (I/C) highlighted the importance of human dignity in the Constitution of India and the need for technological advancement in India. He emphasized the initiatives of the Supreme Court of India, such as video conferencing, translation of Supreme Court judgments in Hindi language, and improving district judiciary infrastructure. Contributions of Common Service Centers and the role of 8 grassroot functionaries were highlighted in taking forward the Hamara Samvidhan Hamara Samman campaign to the citizens. He also appreciated 75 advocates from the Bikaner Bar Association for their legal services.

The Former CJI addressed the audience to break the bondages of mental subjugation and champion the inherent dignity of citizens. Highlighting the importance of the Hamara Samvidhan Hamara Samman campaign, he urged citizens to form “Samvidhan Katta” to foster constitutional discussions and uphold liberty, equality, and justice. He called for a human chain of support, encouraging citizens to spread the message to 10 new citizens, who would take it forward to another 10 more citizens for legal awareness and empowerment.

A gathering of 900 participants, including representatives from various sectors, including the Bar Association, judicial officers, advocates, VLE's and Tele-Law program officials.



## 2<sup>ND</sup> REGIONAL EVENT IN PRAYAGRAJ

The second regional event of the year-long celebration took place in Prayagraj on 16<sup>th</sup> July 2024 where the event was graced by the Shri Arjun Ram Meghwal, Hon'ble Union Minister of State (I/C) for Law & Justice, along with Chief Justice of the High Court of Judicature at Allahabad, Hon'ble Mr. Justice Arun Bhansali and Executive Chairman of Uttar Pradesh State Legal Services Authority, Shri Manoj Kumar Gupta.

The event witnessed the felicitation of winners of different competition under the Hamara Samvidhan Hamara Samman campaign organised by the DoJ in collaboration with the My Gov Platform. Efforts of the High Court of Judicature at Allahabad on creating a Pro Bono Panel under the Nyaya Bandhu Programme of DoJ were commended and Registrar-General of the Hon'ble Court Shri Rajiv Bharti was appreciated.

A dedicated portal on Hamara Samvidhan was launched that would serve as a knowledge hub for spreading constitutional education among the masses in simple and easy to understand ways and to increase the participation of the citizens.

A gathering of 800+ audience attended the event both physically and digitally. Members from the Bar Association, Village Level Entrepreneurs from Common Service Centers, Senior officials from the Department of Justice, citizens who have won the competition under the campaigns, judicial officers, and representatives from district and local administration participated at the event.

## 3<sup>RD</sup> REGIONAL EVENT IN GUWAHATI

The third regional event was held at the IIT Guwahati, Assam on 19<sup>th</sup> November 2024 where the event was graced by Shri Arjun Ram Meghwal, Hon'ble Minister of State for Law and Justice (Independent Charge) and Minister of State for Parliamentary Affairs along with Hon'ble Mr. Justice Vijay Bishnoi, Chief Justice of the High Court of Gauhati as the Guest of Honour and Hon'ble Mr. Justice Lanusungkum Jamir, Executive Chairman, State Legal Service Authority, Assam attended the program as an esteemed guest.

The event began with a symbolic gesture of planting of saplings to honor the 15 women members of the Constituent Assembly, who played a crucial role in the creation of India's Constitution. This tribute under the campaign of 'Ek Ped Maa Ke Nam' was an attempt to highlight the pivotal yet often overlooked role of women in shaping the country's democratic foundation.

The event also witnessed the launch of Samvidhan Katta magazine, which showcases 75 stories that illustrate the impact of the Indian Constitution in everyday life, and Comic Book featuring the real-life stories of 10 beneficiaries who have used the Tele-Law and Nyaya Bandhu programs to protect their Constitutional rights, and Eight podcasts, focusing on the role of the Tele-Law and Nyaya Bandhu programs in helping citizens safeguard their rights.


